

IMPORTANT NOTES on some official COLLEGE POLICIES and PROCEDURES\* as they apply to students.

## 1. GROOMING

- a. Students are to wear regulation College uniform <sup>2</sup> all items and complete details available from the Uniform Shop. A Blazer is to be worn during terms Two and Three and at designated formal, whole school functions.
- b. Three significant elements are:
  - x black leather shoes that take a shine;
  - x shirts that can be done up at the collar and
  - x shorts or trousers (i n season) that sit at the waist with a plai n dark belt.
- c. The regulation College rain jacket is part of uniform; it should be large enough to be worn over the College blazer and NOT instead of it.
- d. Hair must be clean, tidy, gel -less, of natural colour, even grade and of a style and length unlikely to cause comment. Students who cannot

## 5. YARD SUPERVISION
